

## **TOP GLOVE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP**

### **Eligibility**

- Citizen of Malaysia
- Obtained CGPA of at least 3.2000 for student who is currently pursuing the degree programme at UTAR
- Obtained admission to Universiti Tunku Abdul Rahman (UTAR)
- Not being bonded or receiving any form of financial assistance from PTPTN / other Foundation / other state government foundation / Corporation scholarship or study loan
- Willing to be bond with Top Glove Group of Companies for 3 to 4 years depending on the duration of the scholarship
- Perform internship in the Top Glove Sdn Bhd during semester break.
- Medically fit
- Did not convict with any legal / criminal case

### **Criteria**

To ensure that the most deserving students are selected for the scholarship awards, the following attributes will be considered:

- Academic achievements
- Financial standing of parent & family members
- Character of candidate
- Extra-curricular activities
- Leadership qualities

### **Interviews**

Only shortlisted candidate(s) shall undergo interview(s) by the Top Glove Foundation

### **Value of Scholarship**

Scholarship covers full tuition fees. Successful candidates will be notified and the decision is final.

Completed forms with relevant documents must be submitted to Division of Examinations, Awards and Scholarships not later than **30<sup>th</sup> September 2020**. Only shortlisted candidates will be called for interview.

## **Terms and Conditions**

Successful candidates are required to bond with the Top Glove group of companies for a period of four (4) years upon the completion of the said Course of Study.

If you wish to apply for release before the commencement of the scholarship bond or to terminate the scholarship bond before the four (4) years stipulated period, you are required to pay back to the TG Foundation double the amount of the total scholarship as awarded to you.
